

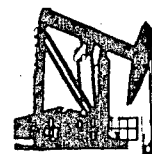

Reference is made to your application for a non-standard location for your Canada Mesa Well No. 3E to be located 790 feet from the North line and 1190 feet from the West line of Section 14, Township 24 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Devils Fork-Gallup and Dakota Formations, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The N/2 of said Section 14 shall be dedicated to the Dakota formation and the NW/4 of said Section 14 shall be dedicated to the Devils Fork-Gallup Formation.
