

The proposed well, the South Malaga 1-2-25-28 well, the South Malaga 1-2-25-28 SWD (formerly the Hoss BHK State No. 1) is beated 1980 PSC and 660' FEL, Section 2, Township 25 South, Range 28 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. Disposal water will be sourced from area wells producing from from area wells producing from the Delaware formation. The disposal water will be injected into the Delaware and Bone Spring formations at a depth of 2677 6484' at a maximum surface pressure of 535 psi and a maximum rate of 3000 BWPD.
