Reference is made to your application of April 3, 1989 for a non-standard oil well location for your Grayburg Jackson West Cooperative Unit Well No. 89 to be located 1345 feet from the North line and 25 feet from the West line (Unit E) of Section 22, Township 17 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Grayburg Jackson (SR-Q-Gb/SA) Pool, Grayburg Jackson West Cooperative Unit, Grayburg Jackson West Waterflood Project, Eddy County, New Mexico. The SW/4 NW/4 of said Section 22 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit.
