2nd Amendment - Administrative Order NSL-2768

Dear Mr. Basham:

Reference is made to your letter dated February 19, 1991 requesting to amend the location of the West Dollarhide Drinkard Unit Well No. 105 which was approved by Division Administrative Order NSL-2768 to be 1411 feet from the South line and 1288 feet from the West line (Unit L) of Section 32, Township 24 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, West Dollarhide Drinkard Unit Waterflood Project Area, Dollarhide Tubb-Drinkard Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that said amendment is necessitated in order to avoid an overhead electric line and underground pipeline. Therefore, by authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104.F.I., said Order is hereby amended to reflect the location of the No. 105 well as 1347 feet from the South line and 1373 feet from the West line (Unit K) of said Section 32, the NE/4 SW/4 of this section to be dedicated to the well.

All other provisions of said Order NSL-2768, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect until further notice.
