Dear Mr. Westbrook:

Reference is made to your application dated April 24, 1990 for a non-standard Jalmat gas well location for your existing Vaughn A-12 Well No. 2 which was drilled in 1977 and completed in the Langlie Mattix Seven Rivers Queen Grayburg Pool at a standard oil well location 660 feet from the North line and 560 feet from the West line (Unit D) of Section 12, Township 24 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding that the Langlie-Mattix zone will be properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted to the Jalmat Gas Pool, which pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, is unorthodox.

Furthermore, it is also our understanding that gas production from the subject well and from your Vaughn A-12 Well No. 1 located 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line (Unit E) of said Section 12, will be simultaneously dedicated to the previously authorized 80-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit comprising the W/2 NW/4 of said Section 12 (Division Administrative Order NSP-289, dated July 11, 1956).

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of said Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described unorthodox gas well location and simultaneous dedication are hereby approved.
