
Dear Michael:

Pool and to rename them as follows:


"Jicarilla 459 #7" to be renamed "Jicarilla 459 C #2"

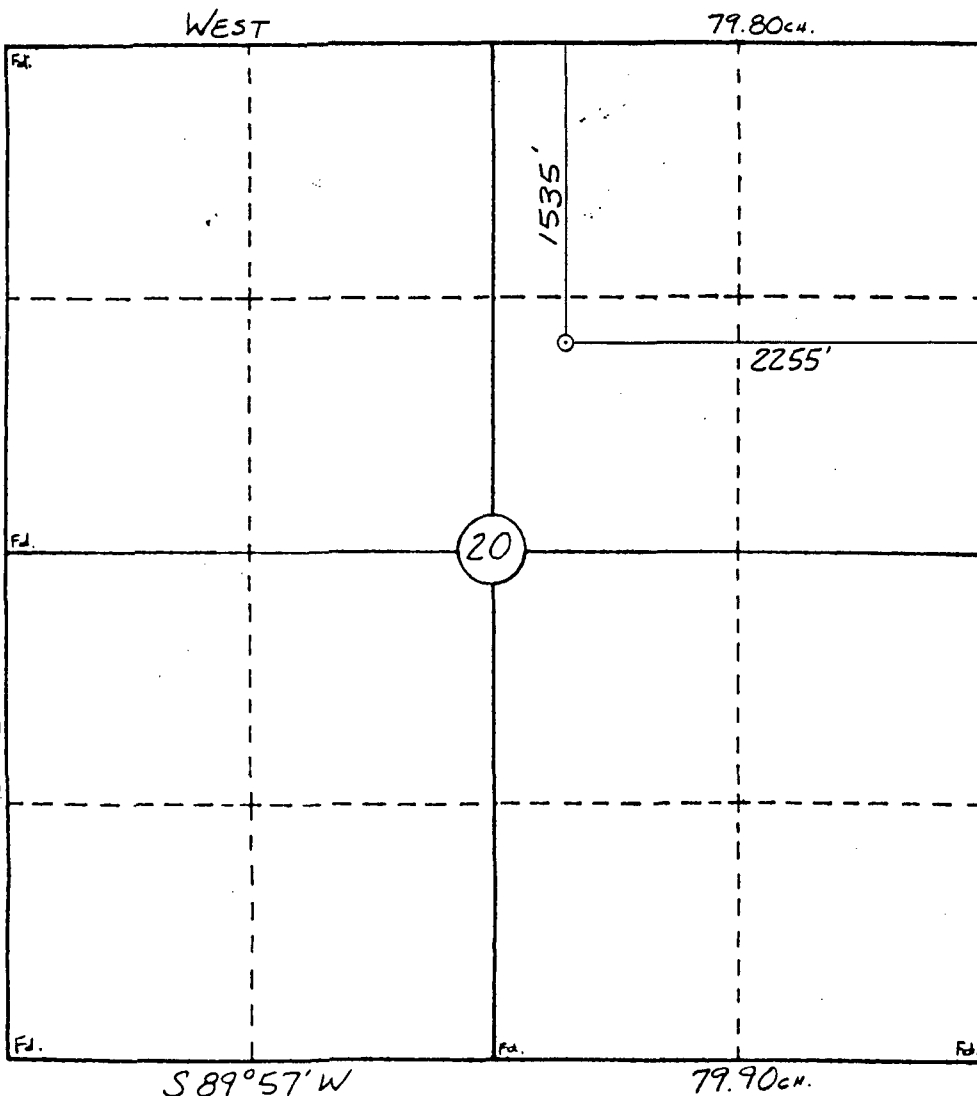
