Gentlemen:

This letter constitutes Mar<u>alex Resources</u>, Inc.'s application for an unorthodox location for the subject well. Maralex has previosly submitted an application to recomplete the subject well to the Fruitland Coal Formation. The well is located 1880 feet from the South line and 1650 feet from the West line of Section 18. Maralex's application designated a lay down drillsite spacing unit for the subject well. The current location of the existing well bore is, therefore, unorthodox as it is less than 790 feet from the northern lease line of the drillsite spacing unit.

The above application for the recompletion was given verbal approval by Mr. Ernie Busch in your Aztec area office contingent upon receiving the unorthodox approval.

By certified copy of this letter all operators of offsetting spacing units are being notified of this application. Ownership of offset spacing units are shown on the attached ownership plat. This plat also shows offsetting wells. The only offsetting well producing from the Fruitland Coal Formation is the Simmons #1 located in the NW_4^1 of Section 17.

Maralex intends to begin the recompletion work on the subject well by the middle of October. Your prompt consideration of this matter is greatly apprecaited.
