Dear Mr. Bohling:

Reference is made to your application dated February 14, 1991 for a non-standard gas well location for your existing Mark Owen Well No. 6 located 554 feet from the South line and 2086 feet from the East line (Unit O) of Section 34, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Tubb Oil & Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. The SE/4 of said Section 34 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 160-acre per spacing and proration unit for said pool.

It is our understanding that the subject well was recently recompleted from the Drinkard Pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 3(b) of the Speical Rules and Regulations for the Tubb Oil & Gas Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
