



#### ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Union Texas Petroleum Corporation made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation on January 24, 1977, for permission to dually complete its Britt "B" Well No. 2 located in Unit N of Section 5, Townshin 20 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Eumont Gas Pool and from the Eunice-Monument Pool.

Now, on this 14th day of February, 1977 the Secretary-Director finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;

(2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and

(3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.

(4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

(5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Union Texas Petroleum Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Britt "R" Well No. 2 located in Unit N of Section 5, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, N⁴PM, Lea County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Eumont Gas Pool and from the Eunice-Monument Pool through the casingtubing annulus and the tubing respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

<u>PROVIDED FURTHER</u>, That applicant shall take macker-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Gas-Oil Ratio Test Period for the Eunice-Monument Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.



#### BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on May 25, 1977, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Richard L. Stamets.

NOW, on this <u>3th</u> day of June, 1977, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

#### FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Union Texas Petroleum, seeks approval of a 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit comprising the E/2 W/2 and W/2 E/2 of Section 7, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, to be simultaneously dedicated to applicant's Britt Wells Nos. 3 and 12 located at unorthodox locations in Units G and C of said Section 7, respectively.

(3) That the entire non-standard proration unit may reasonably be presumed productive of gas from the Eumont Gas Pool and that the entire non-standard gas proration unit can be efficiently and economically drained and developed by the aforesaid wells.

(4) That Commission administrative order NSP-11 should be superseded.

(5) That approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce his just and equitable share of the gas in the Eumont Gas Pcol, will prevent the economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive -2-Caes No. 5935 Order No. R-5448

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


