Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application dated October 2, 1992 for a non-standard Gallup oil well location for Klein Well No. 28E located 1190 feet from the North line and 1590 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Section 33, Township 26 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The NE/4 NW/4 of said Section 33 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit.

Said well is also producing from the Basin Dakota Pool from the W/2 of said Section 33 at a standard location for the Dakota Pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F.(1) the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
