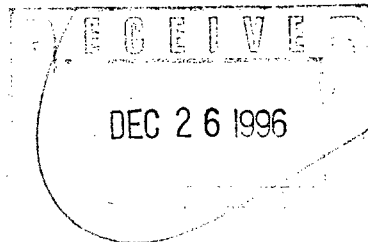

Dear Mr. LeMay:

Chevron U.S.A. Inc. respectfully requests administrative approval for a reclassification of the Scarborough Estate No. 8 from a gas well to an oil well, creation of a non-standard 80 acre oil proration unit, and a standard oil well location.

Well No. 8 needs to be reclassified as an oil well, per OCD guidelines, as the GOR is lower than 50,000 to 1. A non-standard 80 acre oil proration unit is proposed to be dedicated to the No. 8. The location of the new proration unit is the N/2 of SW/4, Section 31, T22S, R38E, making this well a standard well location per the Tubb Oil and Gas Pool regulations.

A copy of this administrative application is being provided to our offset operators via Certified Mail. Attached is a commercial map and a Form C-102 plat illustrating the proration unit acreage and well location. Also included is a copy of the letter sent to our offset operators.

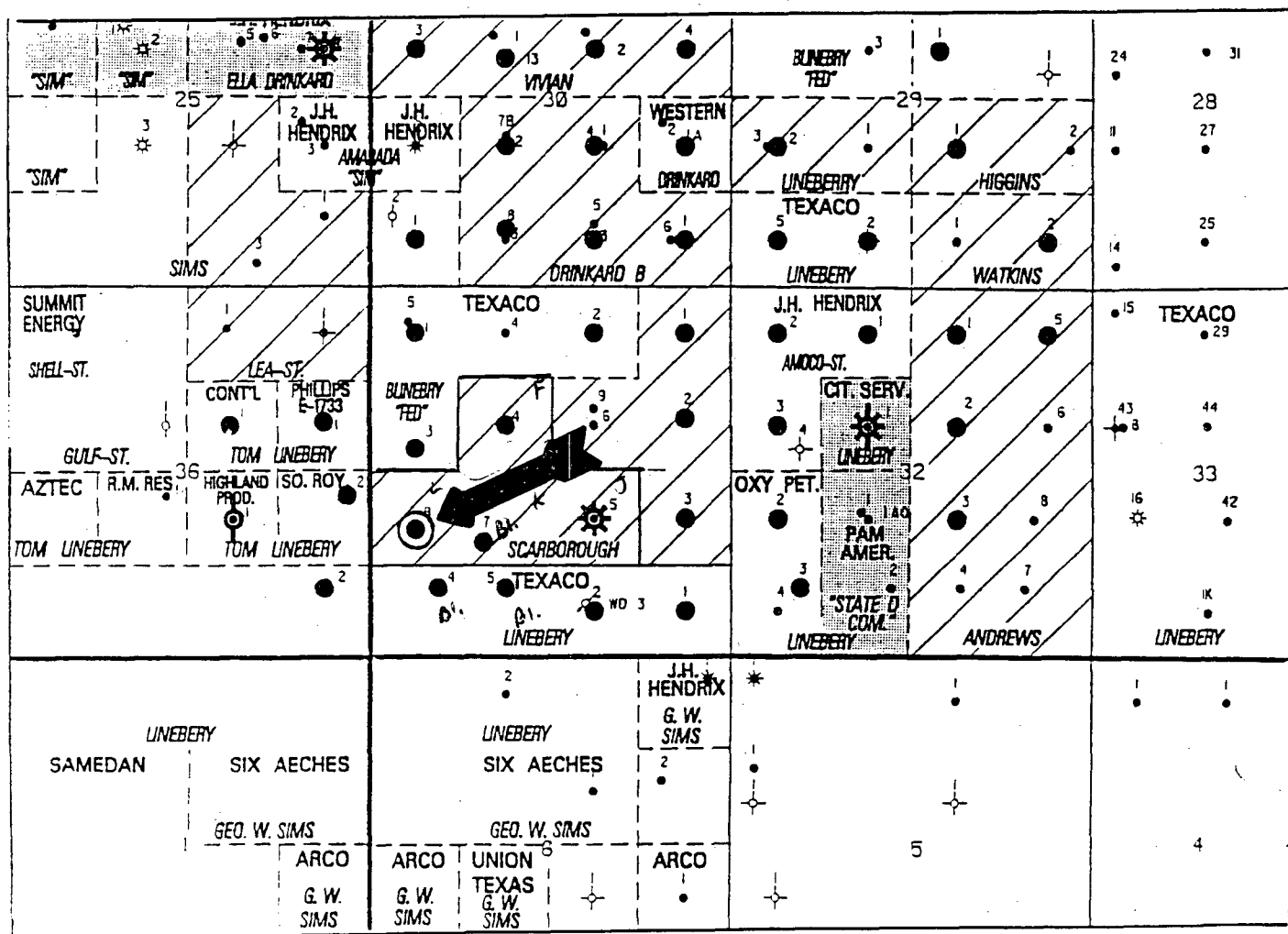

(Reinstatement of Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit: Order No. R-1361)

Dear Mr. Vanderslice:

Reference is made to your application dated November 5, 1992 for a non-standard Tubb gas well location for your existing Scarborough Estate Well No. 8 which was drilled in 1963 and completed in the South Brunson Ellenburger/Blinebry Pool at a standard location 1830 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the West line (Unit L) of Section 31, Township 22 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding that both the Blinebry and Ellenburger zones will be properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted to the Tubb Oil and Gas Pool, which pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the Tubb Oil and Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, is an unorthodox gas well location.

Further, it is our understanding that said well is to be dedicated to a previously approved 160-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit comprising the SE/4 NW/4, N/2 SW/4 and NW/4 SE/4 of said Section 31. By Division Order No. R-1361, dated April 2, 1959, the subject unit was approved for the Gulf Oil Corporation Scarborough Estate Well No. 4 located in Unit F, which ceased producing Tubb gas in 1983. At that time the corresponding unit was also terminated.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of said Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved and shall be dedicated to the 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit approved by Order No. R-1361.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on March 25, 1959, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Elvis A. Utz, Examiner duly appointed by the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," in accordance with Rule 1214 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

NOW, on this 2nd. day of April, 1959, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced and the recommendations of the Examiner, Elvis A. Utz, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Gulf Oil Corporation, is the owner and operator of the SE/4 NW/4, the NW/4 SE/4 and the N/2 SW/4 of Section 31, Township 22 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

(3) That the applicant is the owner and operator of the dually completed Scarborough Estate Well No. 4, located 1980 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the West line of said Section 31.

(4) That the applicant proposes the establishment of two 160-acre non-standard gas proration units consisting of the above-described acreage, one for the Tubb Gas Pool, the other for the Blinebry Gas Pool, with the said Scarborough Estate Well No. 4 as the unit well for each of such non-standard units.

(5) That the entire acreage in the proposed non-standard gas proration units may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas from the Tubb Gas Pool and the Blinebry Gas Pool.

(6) That approval of the subject application will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Tubb Gas Pool and a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Blinebry Gas Pool, each consisting of the SE/4 NW/4, the NW/4 SE/4 and the N/2 SW/4 of Section 31, Township 22 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, be and the same are hereby established. Said units are to be dedicated to the applicant's Scarborough Estate Well No. 4, located 1980 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the West line of said Section 31.

(2) That Administrative Orders NSP-471 and 472 are hereby cancelled.
