Reference is made to your application dated December 14, 1992 on behalf of Socorro Petroleum Company for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within an existing secondary recovery project for the H.E. West "A" Well No. 19 to be located 1305 feet from the South and East lines (Unit P) of Section 4, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Grayburg Jackson Seven Rivers-Queen-Grayburg-San Andres Pool, Keel-West Waterflood Project Area, Eddy County, New Mexico. Said well to be dedicated to the existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the SE/4 SE/4 (Unit P) of said Section 4.
