We request administrative approval for this unorthodox location due to rough topography.

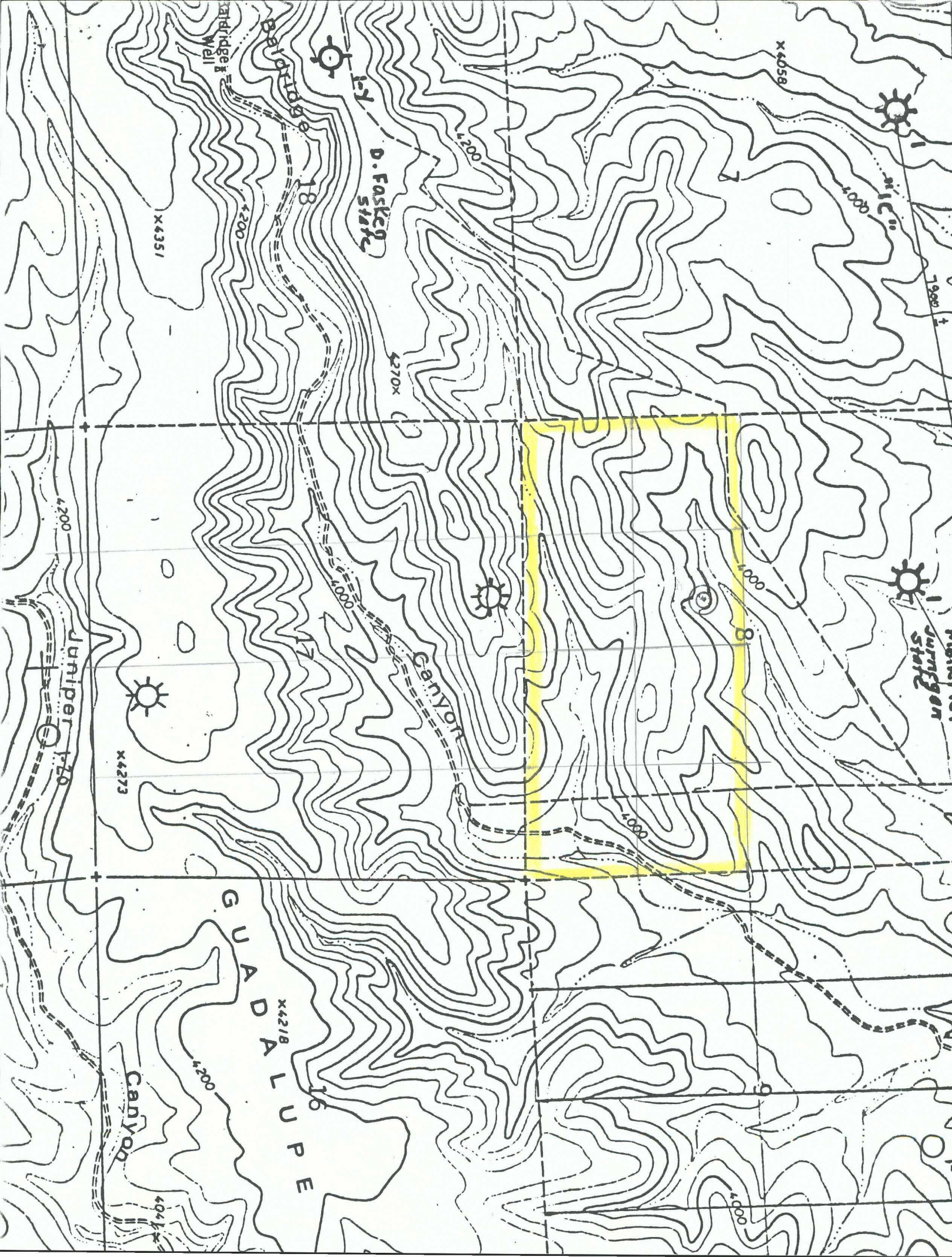
Attached is a copy of the topog sheet of the area and three waiver letters I have already recieved.
