

Dear Mr. Sanders:

Reference is made to your applications dated February 19 and 25, 1993 for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within an active secondary recovery project for your Vacuum Abo Unit, Tract 14 Well No. 5 to be located 1475 feet from the South line and 430 feet from the West line (Unit L) of Section 5, Township 18 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Vacuum-Abo Reef Pool, Vacuum Abo Pressure Maintenance Project Area, Lea County, New Mexico. Said well to be dedicated to the existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the NE/4 SW/4 of said Section 5.
