

ADMINISTRATIVE APPLICATION

Comes now RKI EXPLORATION & PRODUCTION, LLC ("RKI") and by and through its attorneys, Kellahin & Kellahin, and in accordance with Division General Rule 104.F, applies to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") to amend Division's administrative order NSL-5692, dated October 3, 2007, approving the location for production from the Herrudura Bend-Delaware to also include approval of this unorthodox well location for the South Culebra Bluff-Bone Spring Pool, an 80-acre spacing pool, in the event this well is productive from said pool. Pinnacle State Well No. 16 is located 1152 feet from the South line and 2528 feet from the West line (Unit N) of Section 36, T22S, R28E, Eddy County New Mexico and if productive will to dedicated to a standard 80-acre oil spacing unit consisting of the E/SW/4 of this section.

In support, RKI states:

- 1. RKI's Pinnacle State Well No. 16 is located in Unit N of Section 36 and if productive in the Bone Springs formation will be located within 1-mile of the outer boundary of the South Culebra Bluff- Bone Spring Pool and among other things, subject to a standard 80-acre spacing units.
- 2. In that event, RKI would dedicate the E/2SW/4 of Section 36 to this well. The well would encroach towards that SE/4 of Section 36 where RKI and its affiliated entities own three of the four 40-acre tracts with Chevron USA owning the SE/4SE/4.

- 3. RKI is drilling this well and desires to test the Bone Spring formation as part of this well. See locator map attached as Exhibit "A"
- 4. All of the offsetting wells were drilled to the Bone Spring formation but only produce from the Delaware formation.

NOTIFICATION AND OWNERSHIP

- 5. All of the S/2 of Section 36 is part of the same State of New Mexico Oil and Gas Lease V-3491-1 with Chevron being the WIO for the SE/4SE/4 and with RKI and its affiliated entities being the WIO for the balance of this half-section.
- 6. While the SE/4 does not currently contain any Bone Spring wells, hypothetically the SE/4 could contain an 80-acre spacing units consisting of the S/2SE/4 and thus including Chevron's tract.
- 7. Notice will be sent to Chevron USA in accordance with Division rules. See Exhibit "B"

CONCLUSION


