Apache Corporation is hereby authorized to surface commingle Bronco; Siluro Devonian Pool (7410) oil production from the following Federal leases.

Commingled oil production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the HD Schenck Tank Battery located in Unit A of Section 14, Township 13 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

Oil production from the Federal A Lease shall be measured continuously with calibrated allocation meters prior to commingling with the HD Schenck production for sales. The commingled oil and gas production from the Federal A Lease is approved for off-lease measurement and sales.

Oil production from the HD Schenck Lease shall be measured continuously with calibrated allocation meters prior to commingling with the Federal A Lease production for sales.
