Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application dated February 22, 1994, for a non-standard gas well location for the proposed Johnston "A" Com Well No. 5 to be drilled 1405 feet from the North line and 875 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 32, Township 26 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, to test both the Blanco-Mesaverde and Basin-Dakota Pools, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The N/2 of said Section 32 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for both pools..

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for both the Blanco-Mesaverde and Basin-Dakota Pools, as promulgated by Division the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
