Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application dated March 2, 1994, for a non-standard oil well location for your Cullins Federal Well No. 6 to be drilled 1510 feet from the South line and 2390 feet from the East line (Unit J) of Section 4, Township 24 North, Range 3 West, NMPM, West Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The SE/4 of said Section 4 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 160-acre oil spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 5 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the West Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No R-4314-A, as amended, the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
