Dear Ms. Baldwin:

Reference is made to your application dated March 14, 1994 on behalf of the operator, Merit Energy Company, for a non-standard oil well location for the proposed Jicarilla "K" Well No. 10E to be drilled 1370 feet from the South line and 1440 feet from the West line (Unit K) of Section 1, Township 25 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Undesignated West Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The SW/4 of said Section 1 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 160-acre oil spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 5 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the West Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-4314-A, the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
