Reference is made to your application dated March 30, 1994 for a non-standard oil well location for your Gila "13" Federal Well No. 1 to be drilled 1928 feet from the North line and 1049 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 13, Township 24 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, Undesignated Northwest Poker Lake-Delaware Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico. The SE/4 NE/4 of said Section 13 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit.
