Reference is made to your application dated August 31, 1994 for a non-standard gas well location for your proposed Scott E. Federal "22" Well No. 22 to be drilled 2630 feet from the North line and 2626 feet from the West line (Unit F) of Section 22, Township 27 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The NW/4 of said Section 22 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit.
