Reference is made to your application dated September 13, 1994 on behalf of the operator Devon Energy Corporation for a non-standard oil well location for its proposed Todd "23-H" Federal Well No. 6 to be drilled 2470 feet from the North line and 415 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 23, Township 23 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Undesignated Ingle Wells-Delaware Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico. The SE/4 NE/4 of said Section 23 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit.
