Reference is made to your application dated February 21, 1995 for a non-standard gas well location in the Basin-Dakota Pool for your proposed Canyon Largo Unit Well No. 427 to be drilled 900 feet from the South line and 2215 feet from the West line (Unit N) of Section 11, Township 25 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The W/2 of said Section 11 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of the "Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Dakota Pool", as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
