Dear Ms. Staley:

Reference is made to your application dated March 21, 1995 for a non-standard Gallup gas well location for your existing E. J. Johnson "C" Well No. 1 (API No. 30-045-06361), which was drilled in 1964 and completed in the Basin-Dakota Pool at a standard gas well location 1600 feet from the South line and 940 feet from the West line (Unit L) of Section 21, Township 27 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that Amoco intends to properly plugged back the Dakota interval and recomplete said well up-hole into the Undesignated Angles Peak-Gallup Associated Pool.

By the authority granted me under the provision of Rule 2(c) of the "*General Rules and Regulations for the Associated Oil and Gas Pools of New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations for the Angels Peak-Gallup Associated Pool*", as promulgated by Division Order No. R-5353, as amended, the above-described unorthodox Gallup gas well location is hereby approved. Further, the W/2 of said Section 21 shall be dedicated to said well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.
