Dear Mr. Wood:

Reference is made to the following: (i) your application on behalf of the operator, MarkWest Resources, Inc. ("MarkWest"), that was submitted to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") on January 28, 2003 (*application reference No. pKRV0-302929838*); and (ii) the Division's records in Santa Fe and Aztec: all concerning MarkWest's request to drill its proposed Las Colinas Well No. 100 at an unorthodox Pictured Cliffs gas well location 2005 feet from the North line and 414 feet from the West line (Unit E) of Section 26, Township 30 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

The NW/4 of Section 26 is to be dedicated to this well in order to form a standard 160-acre gas spacing unit for the Undesignated Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool (77200).

This application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rule 104.F, revised by Division Order No. R-11231, issued by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission in Case No. 12119 on August 12, 1999.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division Rule 104.F (2), the above-described unorthodox Pictured Cliffs gas well location is hereby approved.
