Reference is made to your application dated May 9, 1998 for Burlington Resources Oil and Gas Company to drill its San Juan "28-5" Unit Well No. 107 at an unorthodox gas well location within the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool 1600 feet from the South line and 255 feet from the West line (Lot 4/Unit L) of irregular Section 12, Township 28 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. All of said Section 12 is to be dedicated to said well in order to form a standard 299.04-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(d) of the "General Rules for the Prorated Gas Pools of New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
