Dear Edward,

Given below is our quarterly update for the above referenced Rice Operating Company project, Vacuum K-35-1.

We have been recovering groundwater at the above referenced site since July of 2008 per the respective Corrective Action Plan. To date we have recovered approximately 2,600 bbls of water from this location and used this water for SWD line maintenance. We have recently shut this system in due to the impossibility of keeping from freezing and damaging the equipment over the winter months.

The attached graph illustrates the cumulative amount of groundwater removed over time as well as the (field measured) groundwater chloride concentrations. It appears that we are making significant progress in reducing groundwater chloride mass. We will more fully evaluate these data and report our findings and recommendations to you before resuming groundwater withdrawals after winter has passed.
