Dear Mr. Brooks:

West Largo Corp. respectfully requests that an unorthodox location be administratively approved for the State Com 32 No. 2 well in accordance with the terms of Rule 104.F(2). Attachments included with this letter include a C-102 showing the proposed unorthodox location, a vicinity map showing the Basin Fruitland Coal wells and spacing units in the sections contiguous to the west boundary of section 32, a topographic map of the section, a list of the operators in the affected spacing units to the west, a copy of the cut / fill diagram showing the conflicting facilities and an expanded scale topographic map.

The proposed location is unorthodox to the west section line of Section 32. The proposed location is situated in the bottom of an unnamed drainage at the base of the west slope of Harris Mesa. This proposed site was picked due to topographic problems associated with drainages off Harris Mesa and existing wellsite and pipeline locations. Site 1 indicated on the expanded scale topo would share location with the existing Conoco Phillips well which would put it too close to this Pictured Cliff producer and would also place it in a drainage that could create safety issues with materials eroding from the talus slope above. The NW corner of the legal window is located in the old reserve pit area of this existing location and also has a pipeline running through it. Site 2 would be a shared pad scenario with Conoco Phillips on their State N # 1M. This small location is currently filled with equipment for the existing well and it is not likely they will shut down this wells operation for the drilling and completion of our well. They have not been approached about this option. The proposed location was laid out to the west side of the existing road / pipeline right of way to this location, in between the two wells.

The closest offset Fruitland Coal well is approximately 1800 feet northeast of this proposed location. The closest offset on the west side is 2550 feet.

Operators of the Basin Fruitland Coal wells to the west have been provided notice of this application by certified mail.

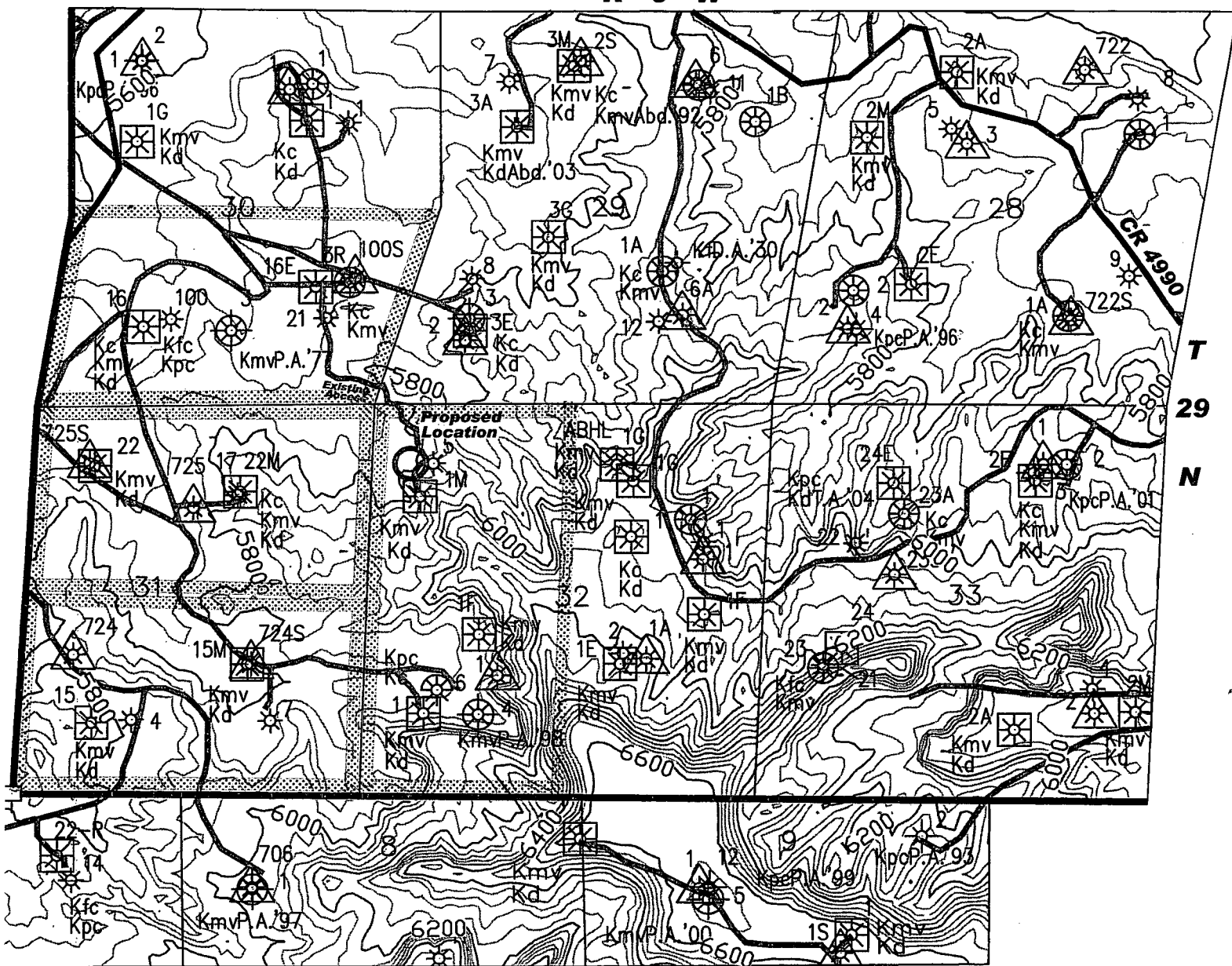

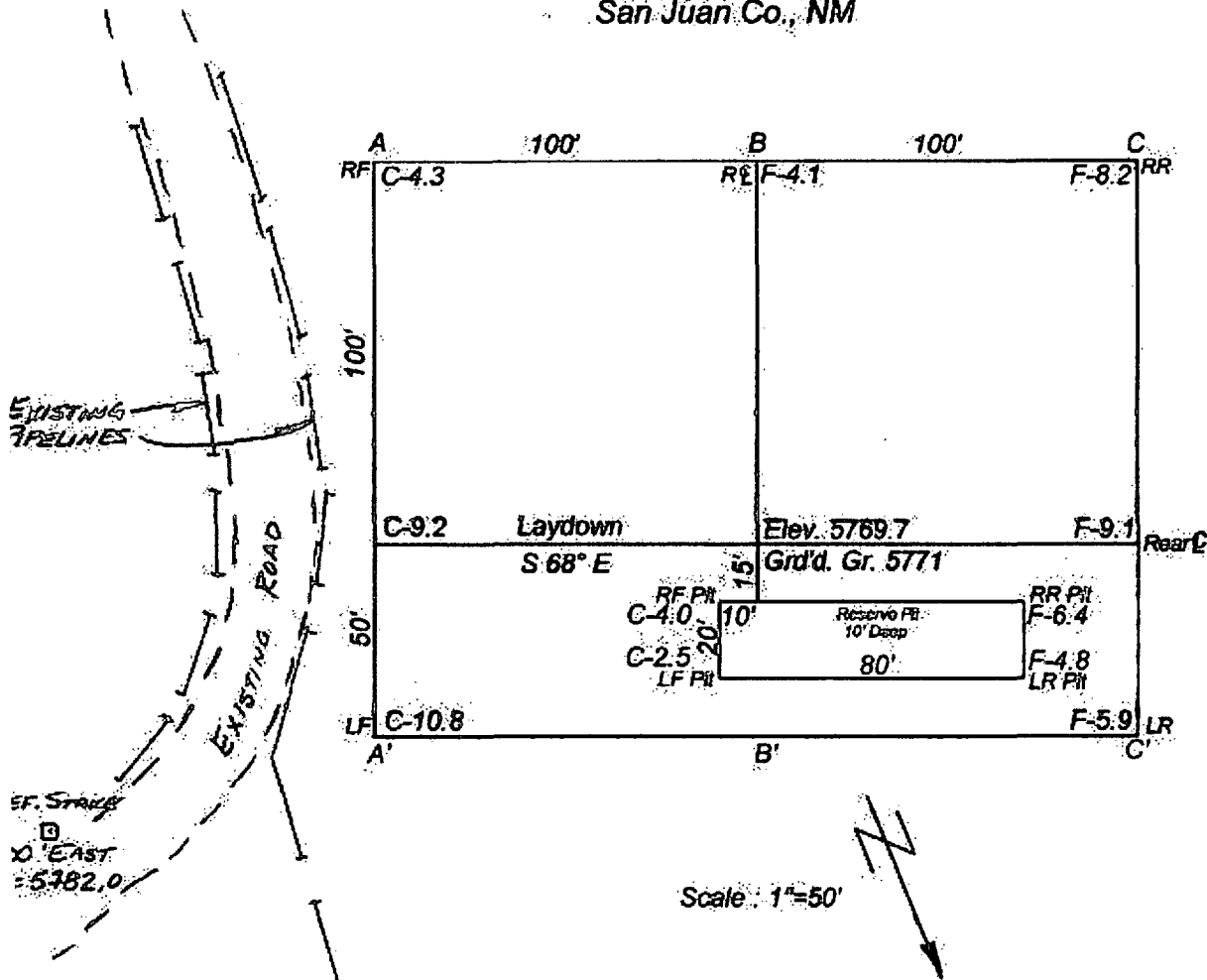
