As per the letter from the BLM, Sundance Services has conducted their own investigation of the complaint filed by the BLM. On March 03, 2009 I talked to David Raines who is the foreman for Wallach Concrete and he informed me that none of the employees had any complaints concerning headaches or nosebleeds. His phone number is 575-394-2504. On March 26, 2009 I also talked with Sheila Parker who is the director for environmental with Waste Control Specialists ,LLC. Her phone number is 575-394-3300. I spoke with Richard Wyckoff who is the Environmental Compliance manager for Waste Control Specialists, LLC. They have not had any complaints from any of their employees concerning the headaches and nosebleeds.

On March 26, 2009 I visited with Brenda Brooks who is the Director of Communications for LES. Her phone number is 575-394-4646.

She has not heard of any complaints from any of her employees.

I talked with John Cook who is the project manager for Quality Inspection Services Inc. His phone number is 505-908-1279. They are located on Wallach's property just east of Pit # 4. They have had some employees complain about nauseting ordors. They have had Air Quality Control come out there and do some testing and all the tests were below the hazardous levels. He told me that their employees were not used to the West Texas oil patch smell. All they are trying to accomplish is for thier office to be moved away for Pit # 4. They were told by their corporate office that it is not uncommon to have this sort of reactions if you were not used to this climate. He also stated that the sand and dust did not help matters. All the employees wanted was a better quality of workplace which they will be moving in two weeks.

Quality Inspection Services, Inc did not call the BLM. The BLM just came in their office trying to find Wallach's office. They began talking and the subject came up about the smell.

Wayne this is just an informal report. Also I would like to add on Zach Ramos report that Donna Roach and Gary Laing are no longer employed by Sundance Services, Inc.

Thanks again for all the help the OCD has given to Sundance Services, Inc. We will continue to work on hand with the OCD.

On March 25, 2009, Wayne Price and Edward J. Hansen of the Environmental Bureau, OCD, telephoned Mark Lewis of the BLM (Carlsbad Office) to discuss a complaint that Mark Lewis telephoned in to the OCD Hobbs District Office on behalf of certain "managers" of employees that have been working near the facility. [On March 10, 2009, Edward J. Hansen left a telephone message for Mark Lewis regarding the filed telephone complaint of March 2, 2009 (see attached). On March 25, 2009, Mark Lewis left a telephone message for Edward J. Hansen returning his call of March 10, 2009.]

During the teleconference Mark Lewis reported that he had observed disposal operations at Sundance (from the Wallach Concrete site, which is adjacent to Sundance) in which a tank truck operator did not use a lanyard while on top of a pond berm when disposing of liquids into the pond. In addition, Mark Lewis reported that possible refinery wastes from a tank truck had been disposed at the facility. He also reported odors (presumably,  $H_2S$ ) at the Wallach Concrete site; however, he was not wearing his personal  $H_2S$  monitor as it was left in his truck while he was at the site.

Also, Mark Lewis reported that he had spoken to a manager "David" at the Wallach Concrete site. The manager had told Mark Lewis that he had sent employees home due to vomiting. In addition, Mark Lewis reported that he had spoken to a manager of a subcontractor for LES at the Wallach Concrete site. This manager had told Mark Lewis that he knew of an employee that had a bloody nose while at the Wallach site.

OCD will continue to investigate this complaint.
