Reference is made to your application dated June 3, 1999 on behalf of the operator, Enron Oil & Gas Company ("Enron"), for authorization to drill its Conoco "8" State Com. Well No. 1 to test both the South Empire-Morrow Gas Pool and the Mississippian formation at an unorthodox gas well location for both intervals 1650 feet from the South line and 1550 feet from the East line (Unit J) of Section 8, Township 17 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. The E/2 of Section 8 is to be dedicated to this well in order to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for both intervals.

The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 104.F of the Rules and Regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division").

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division Rule 104.F(2), the abovedescribed unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
