Dear Mr. Williams:

Reference is made to your request dated June 21, 2001 to increase the surface injection pressure on the above referenced well. This request is based on a step rate test conducted on the well on June 18, 2001. The results of the test have been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on this well is justified at this time.


You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following well:

<i>Well and Location</i>	<i>Maximum Surface Injection Pressure</i>
Lentini "1" Federal No. 17	800 PSIG
Located in Unit F of Section 1, Township 23 South, Range 28 East, Eddy County, New Mexico.	

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
