Dear Sir:

Please refer to your Administrative Order NSP-180, dated August 30, 1955, by which you authorized Gulf Oil Corporation to operate the acreage described in the caption hereof as nonstandard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool.

To establish the unit it is necessary to partially consolidate our State of New Mexico Leases Nos. B-229 and B-230. Such partial consolidation has been accomplished by Order of Approval issued by the Commissioner of Public Lands, State of New Mexico, dated November 9, 1955. This Order completes the communitization of the dry gas, condensate, and distillate in and underlying said W/2 of Section 15, described above, that will be produced by and through Gulf's R. R. Bell "C" Well #4 in SE/4 NW/4 of said Section 15, which is the unit well for the subject gas proration unit.

Please place the unit well upon the gas proration schedule, effective upon the date of connection of the well to a gas transportation facility, allocating to it an allowable based upon the 320-acre unit in the Eumont Gas Pool.

Dear Sir:

Gulf Oil Corporation is the Operator of a non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the W/2 of Section 15, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, New Mexico, in the Eumont Gas Pool. The unit well is Gulf Oil Corporation's R. R. Bell "C" Well No. 4 located in the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 15. An application for the approval of this non-standard gas proration unit was filed and by your Administrative Order NSP-180 you approved the formation of the unit and provided for an allowable in accordance with the pool rules based upon the unit size of 320 acres.

Gulf Oil Corporation is the owner of the leasehold interest covering the NW/4 of Section 15 and SW/4 of Section 15 by virtue of State of New Mexico Oil and Gas Leases Nos. B-230 and B-229, respectively. We are applying to the Land Commissioner for approval of the partial consolidation of the two leases for the production of gas from this unit within the limits of the Eumont Gas Pool. The necessary reworking of our R. R. Bell "C" Well No. 4 is now in progress to furnish the unit gas well.

Pursuant to the practice heretofore followed by the Commissioner, you are requested to place the unit well upon the gas proration schedule, effective upon the date of connection of the well to a gas transportation facility, allocating to it an allowable based upon the 320 acre unit in the Eumont Gas Pool.

Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for approval of a 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool comprising the W/2 Section 15, T-21-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is the owner and operator of the R. R. Bell "C" (State) Lease covering the NW/4 Section 15, T-21-S, R-36-E, and the J. F. Janda "C" (State) Lease covering the SW/4 Section 15, T-21-S, R-36-E. These two 160-acre tracts comprise the proposed 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit described above and shown on the attached plat.
- (2) The Oil Conservation Commission has heretofore granted permission to the applicant to dually complete the R. R. Bell "C" #4 in order to enable production from the Eumont Gas Pool through the tubing-casing annulus and production of oil from the Eunice Pool through the tubing. This well is located in the center SE/4 NW/4 Section 15, T-21-S, R-36-E and is properly located with respect to the two nearest boundary lines of the proposed unit to permit the assignment of 320 acres to such well for the purposes of gas proration; therefore, the applicant proposes to use this well for the unit well.
- (3) The proposed non-standard gas proration unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-520 as follows:
 - (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.

- (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- (c) All acreage within the proposed unit may reasonably be presumed productive of gas.
- (d) The length or width of the proposed unit does not exceed 5280 feet.
- (e) By copy of this letter of application, all operators owning interest in the section in which the proposed unit is located and all operators within 1500 feet of the proposed unit well are notified by registered mail of the intent of Gulf Oil Corporation to form the proposed non-standard gas proration unit. (See attached affidavit.)

In view of the existence of the facts herein stated and compliance with the provisions of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission's Order No. R-520, Gulf Oil Corporation requests that the Secretary of the Commission approve the above described non-standard gas proration unit.

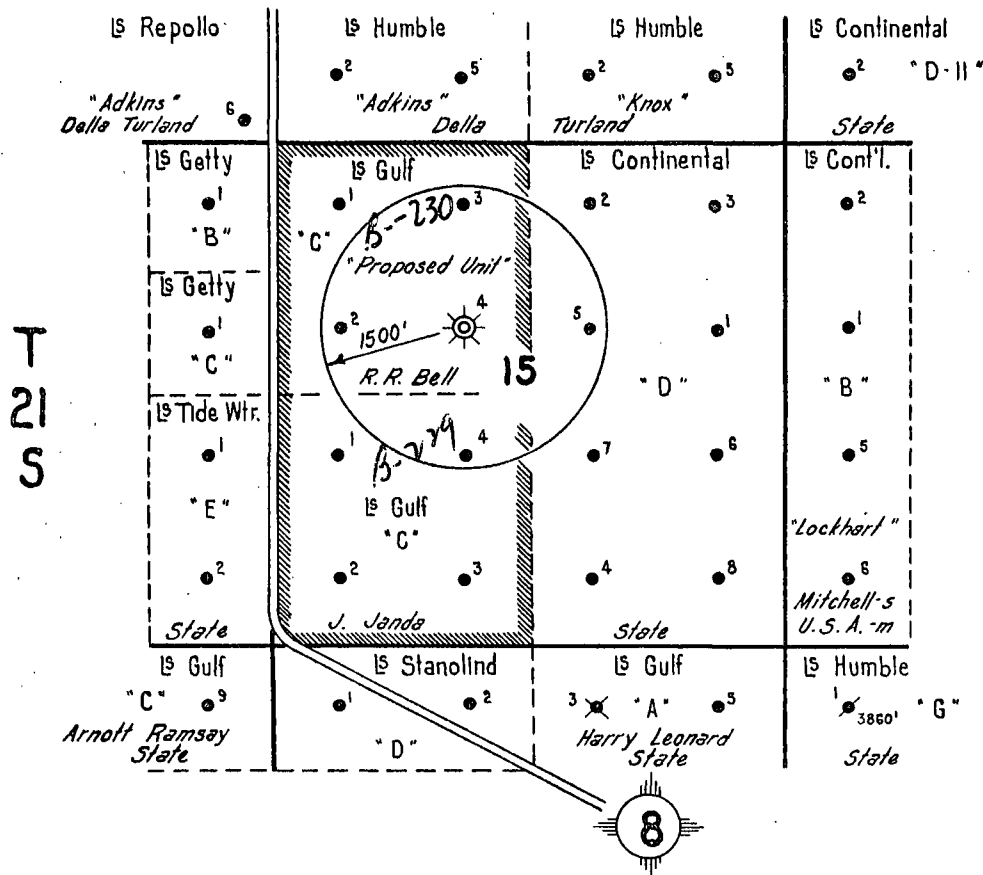
