Gentlemen:

By this application, Southern California Petroleum Corpora-  
tion respectfully requests administrative approval for a Non-  
Standard Gas Proration Unit under Rule 8, Order 640 and Rule  
3, Order 520. 5(6) R-520

1. Acreage involved - SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 25, T24S,  
R36E, Lea County, New Mexico (40 acres).
2. Well involved - Van Zandt Lease, well No. 4,  
located 1650 feet from the north line and 1650  
feet from the east line of Section 25, T24S,  
R36E, Lea County, New Mexico.
3. The well is now producing from the horizontal and  
vertical limits of the Jalmat Pool, as defined by  
Order 640 with a gas-oil ratio of 149,667 to 1,  
which automatically classifies it as a gas well.
4. As outlined by a letter from Mr. A. L. Porter, Jr.  
dated October 4, 1955, we request that this well be  
removed from the oil proration schedule and sub-  
sequently granted a 40-acre gas allowable in the  
Jalmat Gas Pool. The granting of this application  
will not affect adversely any offset operator but  
will protect the correlative rights of the under-  
signed.
5. A plat is hereby attached to this application  
showing (a) acreage to be dedicated, (b) well  
location, (c) offset ownership.

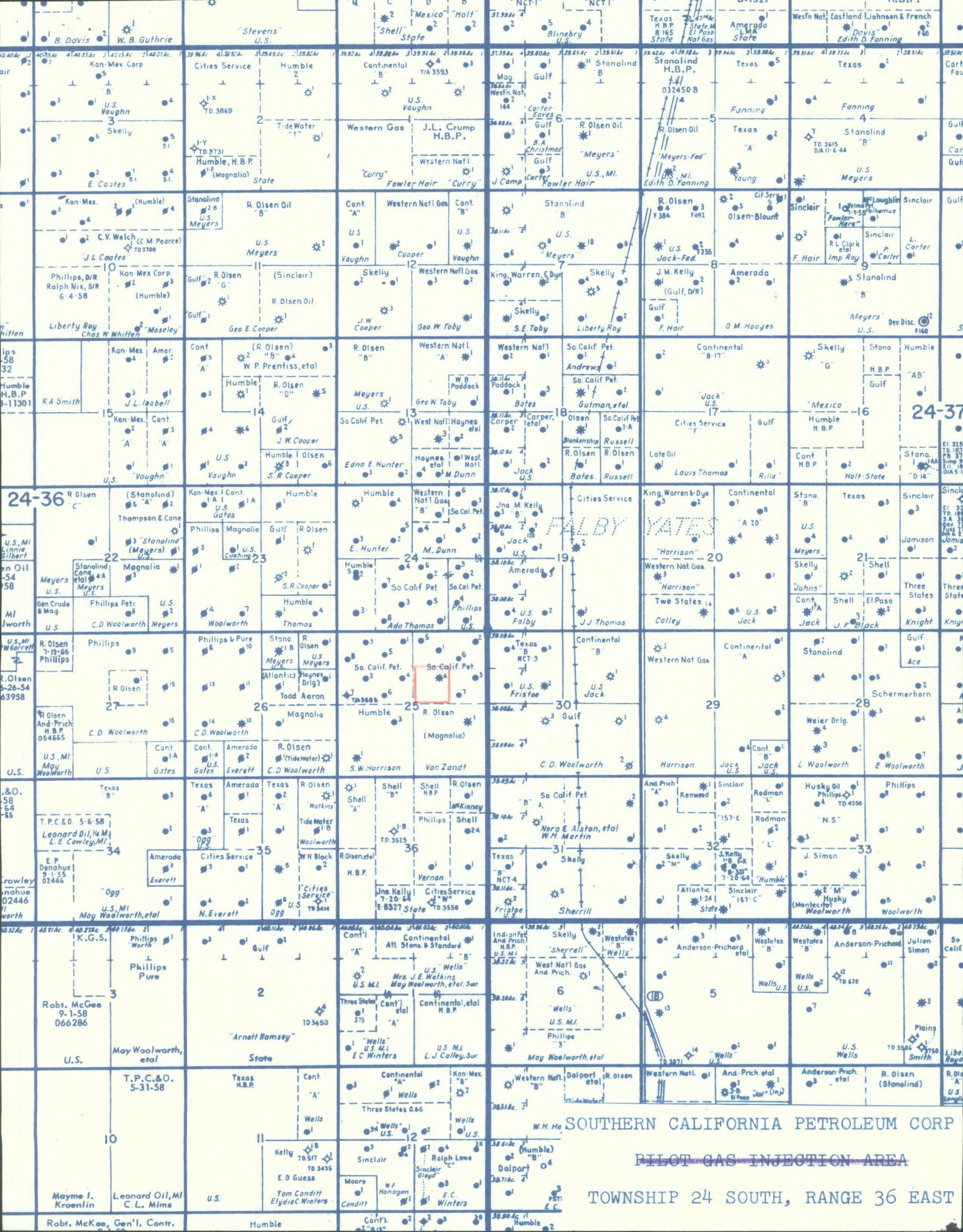

The latest Gas-Oil Ratio report submitted for your Van Zandt #4 in the Jalmat pool shows a Gas-Oil Ratio of 149,667-1, which automatically classifies it as a gas well. It will therefore be necessary for you to file the necessary gas plats showing the acreage which you intend to dedicate to this well, and make an application to the Oil Conservation Commission at Santa Fe for a non-standard gas proration unit. This well will be removed from the oil proration schedule not later than November 30th, or as soon as we are notified that your NSP order has been approved. Under the provisions of Order No. R-640, the maximum acreage which can be dedicated to the above well is 40 acres.


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
