Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 120-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 24 South, Range 36 East, NMPM  
E/2 SE/4 and NW/4 SE/4 of Section 22

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your Magnolia-Myers Well No. 4, located 1980 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line and in the NE/4 SE/4 of Section 22, Township 24 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 120 acres.
