Reference is made to your application for approval of a 321-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 321 acres.
