Gentlemen:

Please consider this the application of Shell Oil Company for an 80-acre non-standard gas proration unit to be dedicated to Shell Taylor-Glenn No. 1, Blinebry (Gas) Field, Lea County, New Mexico. As seen on the attached plat, this well is located 1980 feet FWL and 3226 feet FNL of Section 3, T-21-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

Shell Taylor-Glenn No. 1 was completed as a Blinebry (Gas) producer in August 1956. Currently, 160 acres (outlined in red on the attached plat) are dedicated to this well. However, this request for a non-standard 80-acre gas unit (outlined in green on the attached plat) is the result of (1) the recent recompletion of Shell Taylor-Glenn No. 6 and the recent completion of Continental Hawk B-3 No. 22 in the Blinebry (Oil) Field. Shell Taylor-Glenn 6 and Continental Hawk B-3 No. 22 are located in Lots 10 and 12, respectively, of the above mentioned section.
