Gentlemen:

Please consider this application of Shell Oil Company for a 40-acre non-standard gas proration unit to be dedicated to Shell Livingston No. 11, Blinebry (Gas) Field, Lea County, New Mexico. As seen on the attached plat, this well is located 3300 feet FSL and 660 feet FWL of Section 3, T-21-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

Shell Livingston No. 11 was triple completed as a Blinebry (Oil), Drinkard (Oil) and Tubb (Oil) producer in January 1962. The Blinebry (Oil) production was reclassified as a Blinebry (Gas) well, effective January 1, 1962, on the basis of a recently submitted gas-oil ratio report which showed the well to be producing gas in excess of 32,000 cubic feet per barrel from the Blinebry.

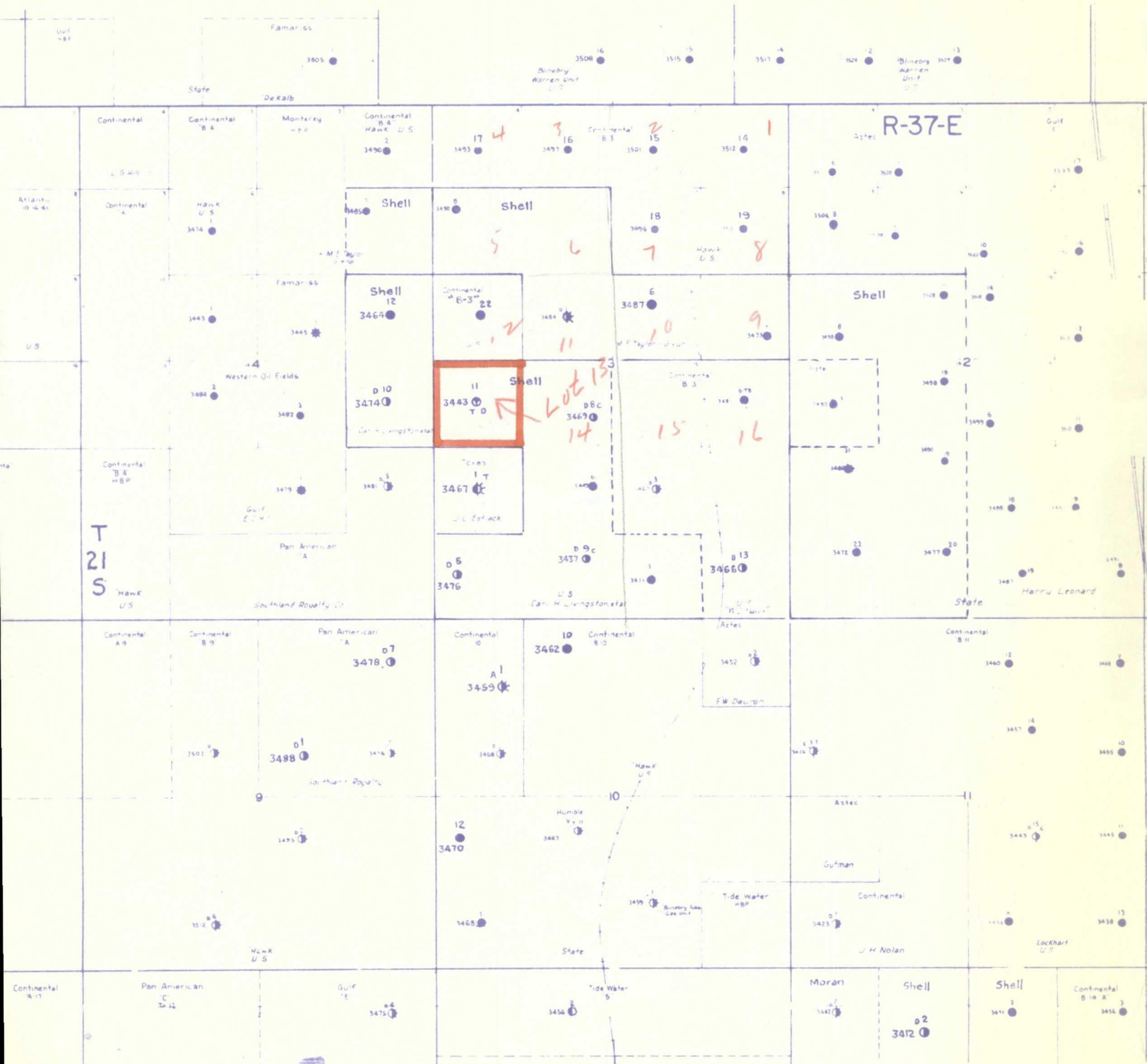
