The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has received the Interim Groundwater Sampling Plan for the above-referenced site, dated January 25, 2010, and has conducted a review of the plan. The plan substantially meets the requirements of 19.6.2 NMAC. Therefore, the OCD hereby approves the plan subject to the following conditions (as per the Plan sections):

1. **3.3.4 Groundwater Laboratory Analyses** The groundwater analyses must also include MTBE and PAH's ("Total Naphthalene").
2. **3.4.1 Groundwater Laboratory Analyses** The groundwater analyses must also include MTBE and PAH's ("Total Naphthalene").
3. **3.6.1 Groundwater Laboratory Analyses** All groundwater analyses must also include PAH's ("Total Naphthalene"). In addition, VOC's per EPA Method 8260B must be analyzed if the GRO analytical results are greater than 80 mg/L and SVOC's per EPA Method 8270D must be analyzed if the DRO analytical results are greater than 200 mg/L.

Please be advised that OCD approval of this plan does not relieve the owner/operator of responsibility should operations pose a threat to ground water, surface water, human health or the environment. In addition, OCD approval does not relieve the owner/operator of responsibility for compliance with any OCD, federal, state, or local laws and/or regulations.
