



Gentlemen:

Pubco Development, Inc., hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard proration unit comprising the West Half ($W\frac{1}{2}$) (or Lots 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, $SE\frac{1}{4}NW\frac{1}{4}$, $E\frac{1}{2}SW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 6, Township 31 North, Range 10 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

1. The Pubco, et al, #1 Primo-Federal well, located 1650 feet from the South line and 1650 feet from the West line of Section 6, Township 31 North, Range 10 West, was completed as a gas well on May 6, 1953, and connected to Southern Union Gas Company line on June 5, 1953.

2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 311.48 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.

3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.

4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.

5. That by copy of this letter of application all operators owning interests (a) in the section in which any part of the non-standard proration unit is situated and which acreage is not included in said non-standard gas proration unit, and (b) in acreage offsetting the non-standard proration unit, are notified by registered mail of this proposed non-standard gas proration unit.


