Gentlemen:

Aztec Oil & Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising the S<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> and NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 20, Township 29 North, Range 11 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof respectfully states and shows the following:

1. That the Aztec-Cozzens No. 4 Well, located 2310 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the West line of Section 20, Township 29 North, Range 11 West, was completed January 15, 1948 as a gas well and connected to Southern Union Gas Company's pipeline on June 10, 1948.

2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 120 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections.

3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.

4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.

5. That so far as is known to Applicant, the following parties constitute the only operators, other than Applicant, owning an interest in any of the acreage included in or offsetting the proposed unit, and such parties are being notified by registered mail of this proposed non-standard gas proration unit by the mailing of a copy of this application to each of them:

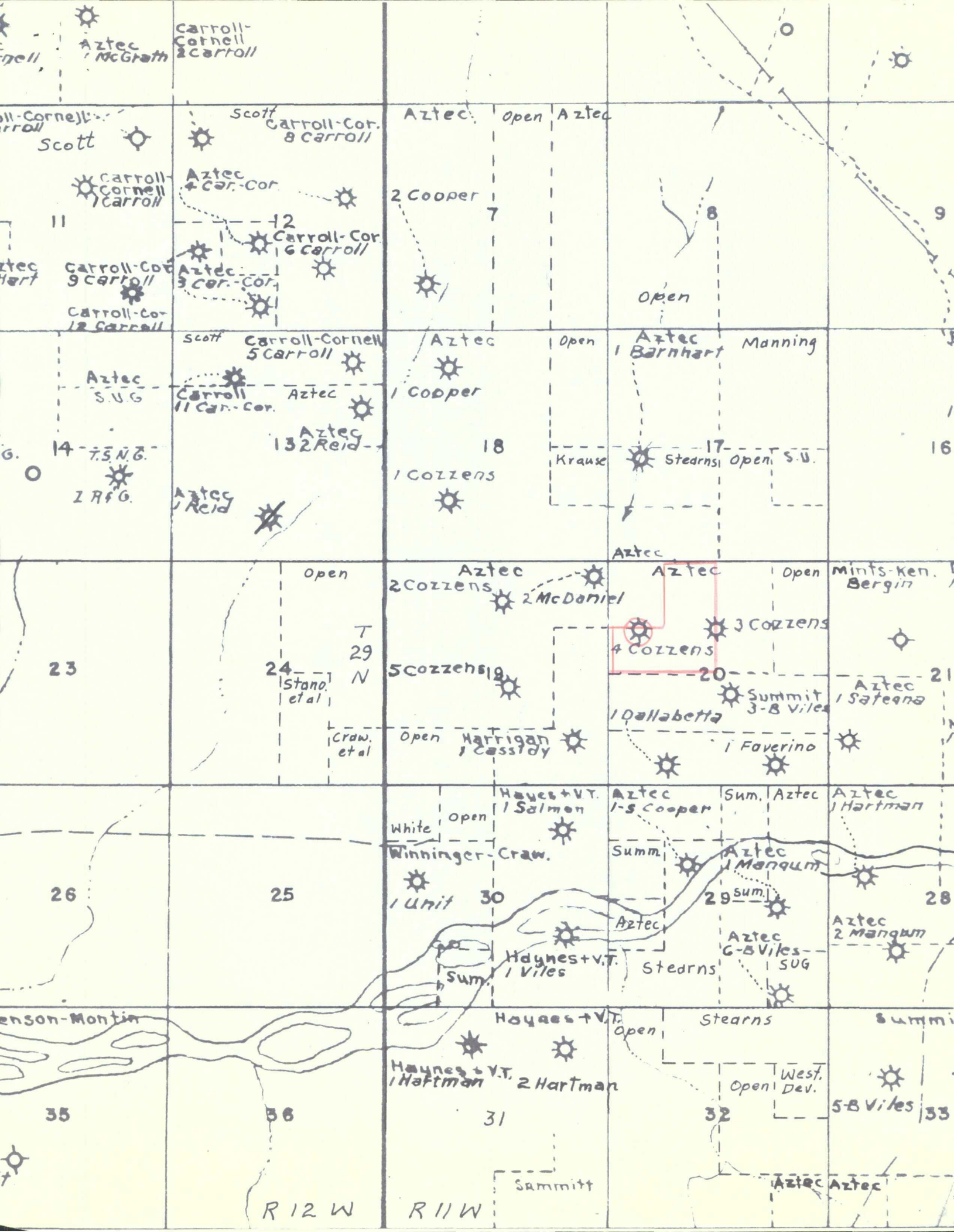
