Gentlemen:

R. H. Wininger hereby submits his application for administrative approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising the $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$; and N $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 30, T. 29N., R. 11W., N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof respectfully states and shows the following:

1. That the R. H. Wininger, Crawford No. 1 well located 2310 feet from the North line and 880 feet from the West line of Sec. 30, T. 29N., R. 11W., was completed October 24, 1950, as a gas well and connected to Southern Union Gas Company's pipeline on December 11, 1950.

2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 160 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections.

3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.

4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.

5. That so far as is known to Applicant, the following company constitutes the only operator, other than Applicant, owning an interest in any of the acreage included in or offsetting the proposed unit, and this company is being notified by registered mail of this proposed non-standard gas proration unit by the mailing of a copy of this application to him with a return receipt requested:

Therefore, R. H. Wininger respectfully requests that under the provisions of Rule 6(b) of Order No. R-565, as amended, the Secretary of the Commission grant an exception to Rule 6(a), without notice and hearing, approving the non-standard gas proration unit hereinabove requested.

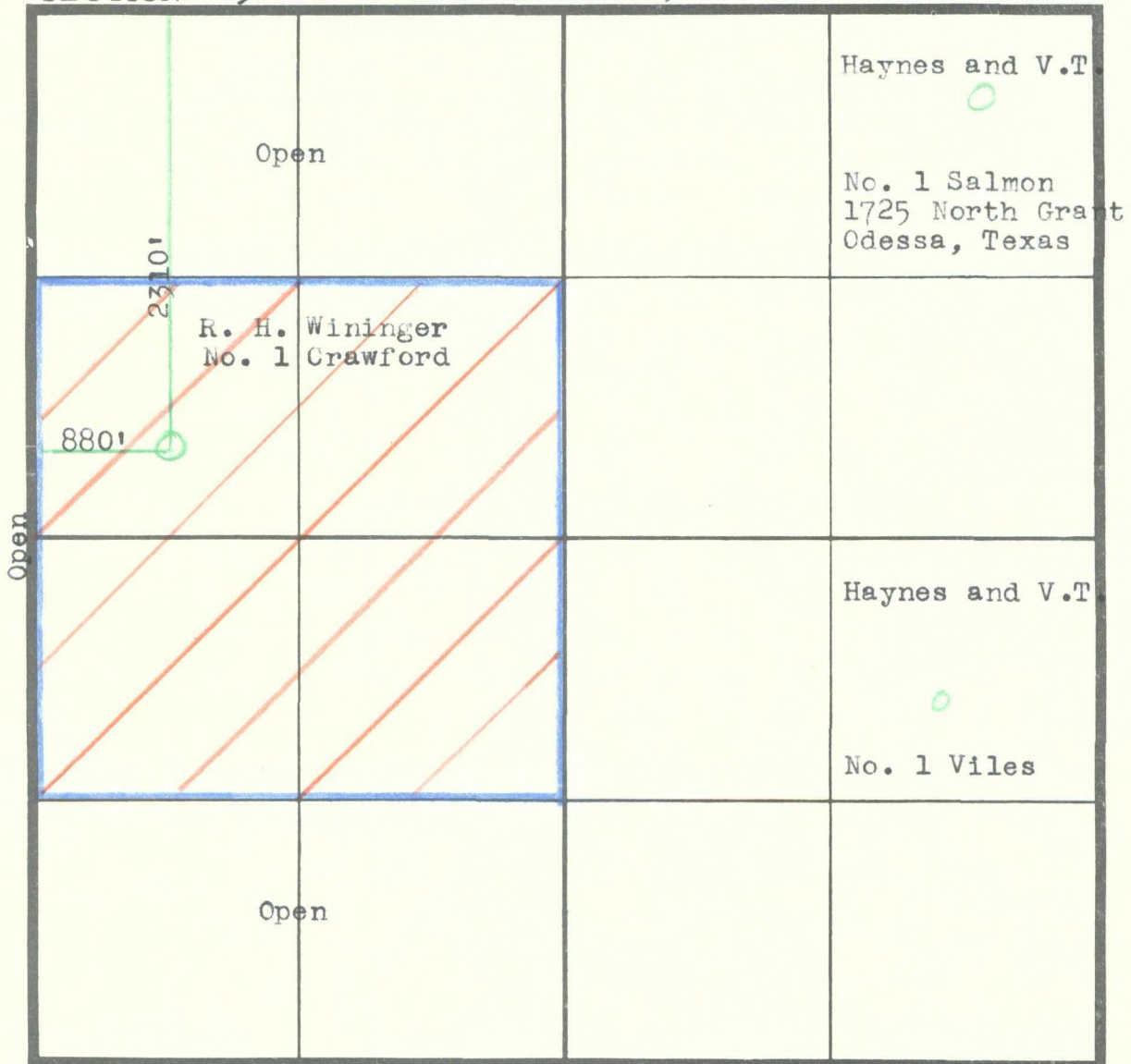
