- The San Juan 29-7 Unit Marshall #1 Well, located 1450' from 1. the South line and 825' from the West line of Section 19. Township 29 North, Range 7 West, was completed as a gas well on January 26, 1953, and connected to El Paso Natural Gas Company's gathering system on April 24, 1953.

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Therefore, El Paso Natural Gas Company requests that under the provision of Rule 1 (b) of Order No. R-128-C, the Secretary of the Commission grant exception to Rule 1 (a) without Notice and Hearing, and approve the subject non-standard gas proration unit.


