Gentlemen:

Aztec Oil & Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising the West Half ($W\frac{1}{2}$) of Section 31, Township 32 North, Range 10 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof respectfully states and shows the following:

1. That the Aztec Harrison No. 1 Well, located 1190 feet from the south line and 1650 feet from the west line of Section 31, Township 32 North, Range 10 West, was completed September 27, 1952 as a gas well and connected to Southern Union Gas Company's pipeline on November 4, 1952.
2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 312.32 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.
3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
5. So far as is known to Applicant, the following companies constitute the only operators other than Applicant owning an interest in any of the acreage included in or offsetting the proposed unit, and such companies are being notified by registered mail of this proposed non-standard gas proration unit by the mailing of a copy of this application to each of them:




Dear Bill:

Mr. Emery Arnold called our attention to three Mesaverde wells in the San Juan Basin on non-standard gas proration units which had not received administrative approval by the Commission. The Harrison and Hill wells were completed in 1952 and 1953, respectively, and were apparently overlooked at the time of mass filing of applications for approval of non-standard units. The Johns No. 1 Well is a recent completion and it also falls in the overlooked category.

I am sorry that these applications were not filed when due, and I hope that no one has been inconvenienced by our failure to do so. If these applications are in proper form, it will be appreciated if you will issue administrative orders for each in due course.


