- 1. The Johnston #7 Well, located 1180' from the South line and 1840' from the West line of Section 11, T-28-N, R-9-W, was completed as a gas well from the Mesaverde Formation on April 16,1957.
- 2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 267.72 acres, which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.
- 3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single government section.




