El Paso applied for an NWU consisting of all of partial section 12 Township 32N Range 10W.

NWU-259 was approved March 17, 1958 showing an application for $\underline{346.80}$ acres and stating that the allowable would be based upon the unit size of $\underline{345.80}$ acres. By not putting this in writing the acreage issue became confused.

We are using the 1881 plat referred to in El Paso's letter. We agree with their figures concerning the unit size. We have issued Supplement #NW-3132 showing 346.80 acres.
