Pursuant to Rule 1(b) of Order R-1287, Aztec Oil & Gas Company hereby submits its Application in triplicate for an exception to Rule 1(a) of such Order and Administrative Approval of a non-standard unit consisting of Lots 5, 6, 7, 8 and SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 5, T-27-N, R-9-W, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico.

In support of this Application, Applicant respectfully states and shows the following:

1. A location has been staked nine hundred and forty feet (940') from the South line and one thousand seven hundred and fifty-five feet (1,755') from the West line of Section 5 for the proposed well to be known as the Hanks #17-D.

2. Applicant owns all the acreage within the section in which the non-standard unit is located, as indicated on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof. The only operators owning offsetting acreage are El Paso Natural Gas Company and Petro-Atlas Petroleum Corporation, and each has been furnished a copy of this Application with a request that their consent in the form of waiver of notice and hearing be forwarded to the Commission.

4. The non-standard unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.

5. The entire non-standard unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.

6. The length or width of the non-standard unit does not exceed 5280 feet.

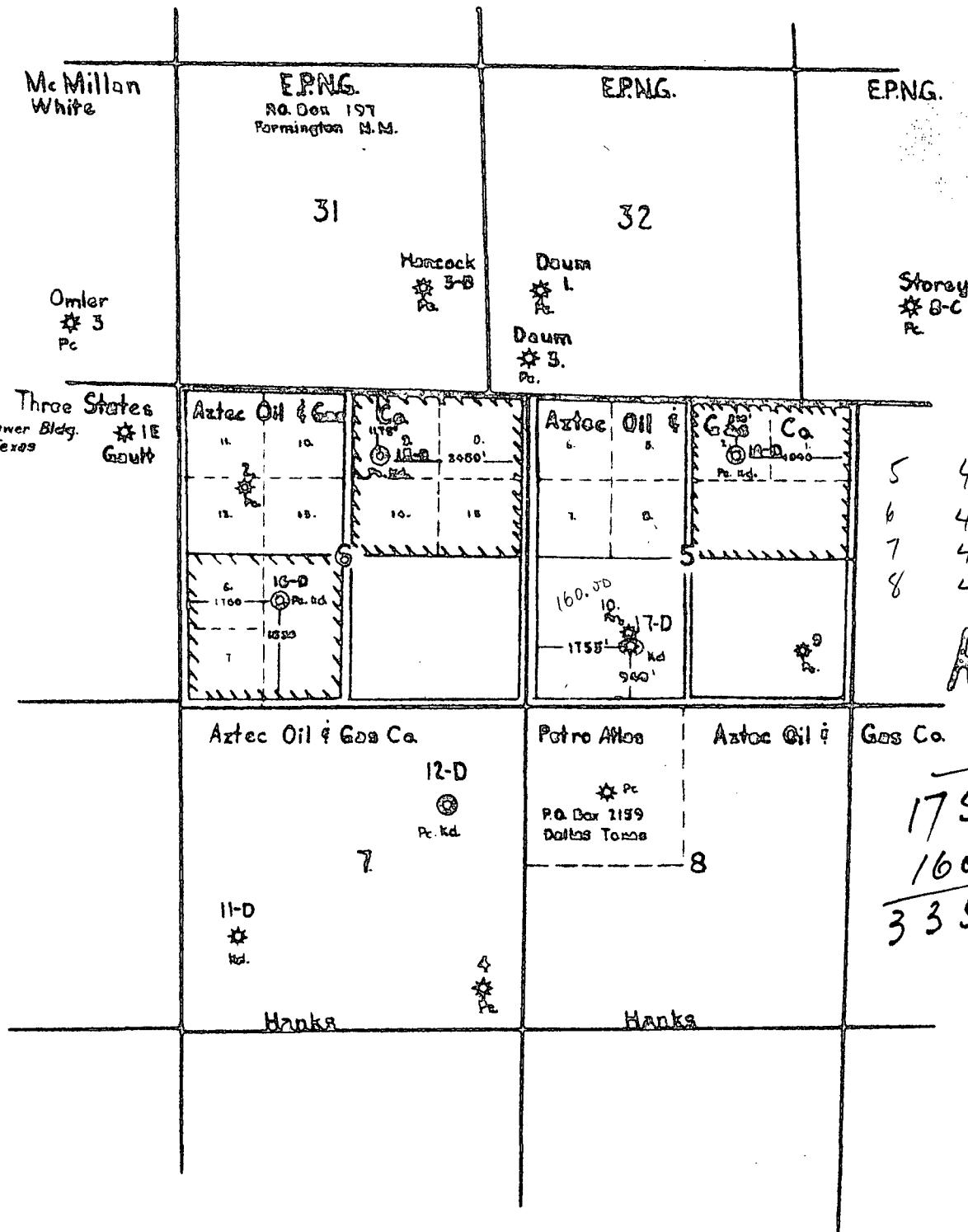
