In accordance with Rule 5(B) of Order R-1670-C, El Paso Natural Gas Company, as Operator, hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a Non-Standard Proration Unit in the Dakota Formation comprising the W/2 (Lots 1,2,3,4, E/2 W/2) of Section 7, Township 27 North, Range 6 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, dedicated to the San Juan 28-6 Unit #103 Well to be located thereon, and in support thereof states the following fact:

That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 315.68 acres which is an unorthodox size or shape due to a variation in the legal subdivision of the United States Public Land Survey. (Plat attached)

Therefore, El Paso Natural Gas Company requests that under the provisions of Rule 5(B) of Order R-1670-C, the Secretary of the Commission grant exception to Rule 5(A) without Notice and Hearing and approve the subject non-standard proration unit.

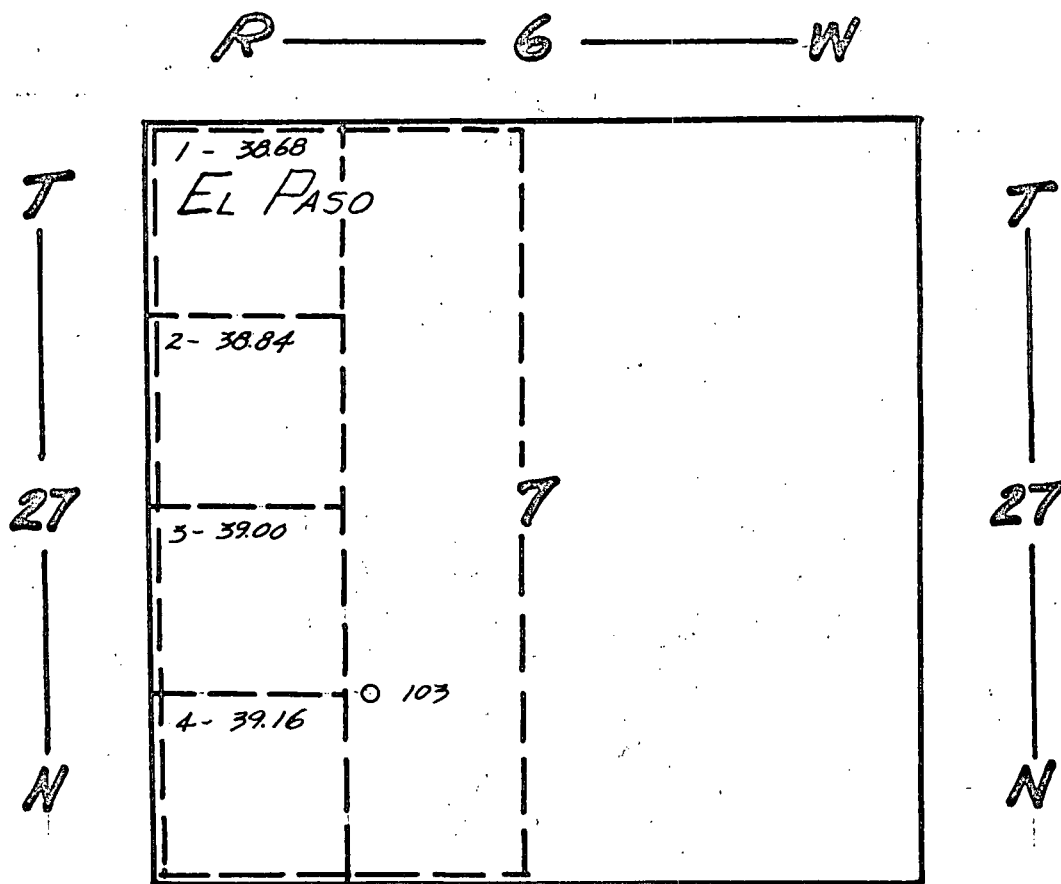
