

Stella Dysart hereby submits her Application for administrative approval of a Non-Standard Unit comprising the West Half (W_2) (or Lots 4 & 5, N $\frac{1}{2}SW\frac{1}{2}$, NW $\frac{1}{2}$) of Section 36, Township 30 North, Range 14 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- 1. The Dysart-Pubco #31 State located 1,650 feet from the South line and 1,650 feet from the West line of Section 36, Township 30 North, Range 14 West, has been drilled and completed as a Dakota Formation Gas Well.
- 2. That the proposed Non-Standard Gas Unit consists of 333.80 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.
- 3. That the proposed Non-Standard Gas Unit lies wholly within a single government section.
- 4. That the proposed Non-Standard gas unit has been found to be productive of gas.
- 5. That the length and width of the proposed Non-Standard gas unit does not exceed 5,280 feet.
- 6. That by copy of this letter of Application all operators owning interests (a) in the section in which any part of the Non-Standard Unit is situated and which acreage is not included in said Non-Standard Gas Unit, and (b) in acreage offsetting the Non-Standard Gas Unit are notified by Registered Mail of this proposed Non-Standard Gas Unit.


