Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*
Operations discovered that the bottom portion of a secondary containment had staining from hydrocarbons. The tank within the containment was removed, placed on skids and filled with water to determine if it was leaking. The tank did not have any leaks. Hydrocarbon impacts surfacing within and outside of the containment may be surfacing due to the recent heavy precipitation in the area. Enterprise is currently taking steps to determine the extent, nature and origin of the hydrocarbon impacted soils.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
The area affected is not known at this time. Surface staining is apparent in approximately 500-600 square feet.

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*
The 6" unloading line from the truck unloading rack to Tank 5201 developed a leak inside the tank retaining dike. The line was blocked in at the tank, line depressured and a clamp was installed at the leak. Leak was a result of external corrosion.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
An area approximately 4 feet wide and 20 feet long and 18 feet deep was stained with crude oil. There was no free liquid. Stained soil will be dug out and disposed of at permitted disposal site and fresh dirt placed in the excavated area.

Any release is that impacts ground water must be reported to the Environmental Bureau Chief in Santa Fe, both verbally and in writing, pursuant to OCD Rule 116 (19.15.3.116 NMAC, RELEASE NOTIFICATION AND CORRECTIVE ACTION). The written report must be on OCD Form C-141 (available at <http://www.emnrd.state.nm.us/ocd/Forms.htm>). If the ground water impact exceeds the WQCC Standards specified at 20.6.2.3103 NMAC, then OCD will require the operator to submit an Abatement Plan pursuant to OCD Rule 19 (19.15.1.19 NMAC).

Your client should submit the information required on OCD Form C-141 and should include a site map depicting the particulars of the spill, a narrative of all actions taken to date, and all analytical data.

Upon discovery the operator shut in all of the wells with lines that run through this conduit and opened them one at a time until he determined which line had the leak. The site will be delineated to determine necessary remediation requirements.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
 The affected area is 27' X 45' and has been fenced off until remediation can take place. A vacuum truck was used to pickup the free standing fluids.
