The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has received the 3rd Quarter Monitoring Results – 2010 for the Schlumberger Oilfield Services Facility - Hobbs, dated August 18, 2010, and has conducted a review of the report. The report, submitted for the above-referenced site, indicates that the Schlumberger Oilfield Services (Schlumberger) is complying with the requirements of 20.6.2 NMAC [Water Quality Control Commission (WQCC) Regulations]. Therefore, the OCD concurs with the recommendations as specified in the report. Please submit a formal request for termination of the remediation and monitoring activities at this site, including, but not limited to:

Source control (i.e., SVE monitoring results that indicate that the source has been eliminated)
Groundwater remediation (i.e., groundwater monitoring results that indicate that the groundwater has been below WQCC regulatory standards for eight consecutive quarterly sampling events for MW-7 and MW-8)
